- A 1-2 page proposal describing the project, how your idea originated, what you hope to accomplish, how the project is related to Montana's heritage and whom will benefit.
- A detailed budget and timeline with a personal resume and your qualifications
- A cover page with name, contact info, project title and total budget amount requested
- Seven copies of your proposal and, if available seven copies of a pervious work.

Funding for projects is competitive. Individual proposals will take precedence over institutions.

Awards range from \$400-\$1000
